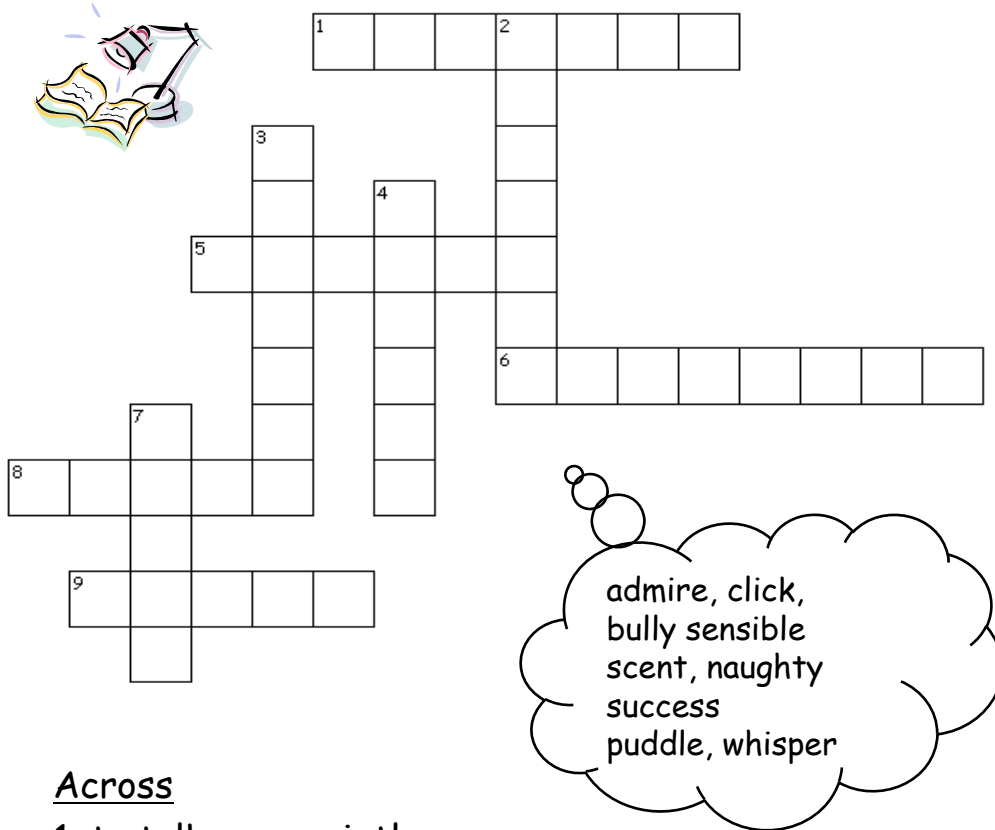

The comparative & superlative forms

Rules to remember

Rule 1: The suffix **er** should be used
when you are comparing two things.
Example: Susan is shorter than Emily.

Rule 2: The suffix **est** should be used
when you are comparing more than two things.
Example: Jessica is the shortest girl in our class

<u>Base</u>	<u>Comparative</u>	<u>Superlative</u>
long	longer	the longest
plump	plumper	the plumpest
naughty	naughtier	the naughtiest
big	bigger	the biggest
good (well)	better	the best
clever	cleverer	the cleverest
fast	faster	the fastest
strong	stronger	the strongest
bad	worse	the worst
beautiful	more beautiful	the most beautiful
difficult	more difficult	the most difficult
